Pianist Michael Serio, a Buffalo native, began his studies with James Kosnik and August Martin at the Villa Maria Institute. He began performing solo concerts as a teenager and was awarded a full scholarship to the Eastman school where he studied with Maria Luisa Faini and Barbara Lister-Sink. Mr. Serio finished his undergraduate studies at the University of Buffalo under Stephen Manes.

In 1986, Mr. Serio moved to Boston where he studied occasionally with Andrew Rangell. In 2002, he had the good fortune to begin studies in the Alexander Technique with pianist Debi Adams. The Alexander Technique transformed his playing (and life) and in 2006, he enrolled in Tommy Thompson's program where he received his Alexander Technique teaching certification in 2009.
